Enjoy the John and Mable's Museum Tour, an introduction to the Ringling's travels through Europe and some of the master works on view in their magnificent museum; the Circus Museum, featuring the Ringling family and the great American circus; and Ca d'Zan Mansion, the main living spaces of the Ringling's beloved winter home. The first two are docent-led tours, but you always have the option of your own self-guided tour of the Mansion, Museum, and all its exhibits.

Florida Museum of Natural History Samuel P. Harn Museum of Art

The Florida Museum of Natural History, the state's official natural history museum and the largest in the Southeastern U.S., houses more than 28 million specimens of amphibians, birds, butterflies, fish, mammals, mollusks, reptiles, and vertebrate and invertebrate fossils. Dickinson Hall houses most of the collections and research activities. Powell Hall is the main Education and Exhibition Center. McGuire Hall houses the Center for Lepidoptera and Biodiversity, in which we will enjoy a docent-led tour for the 6,400-square-foot Butterfly Rainforest exhibit, a screened enclosure of lush subtropical and tropical trees and plants that supports hundreds of living butterflies and moths from all corners of the globe. The Samuel P. Harn Museum is dedicated to promoting the power of the arts to inspire and educate people and enrich their lives. Nearly 7,000 works are represented in the museum's various collections, which include photography; Asian, African, modern and contemporary art; and traveling exhibitions. The museum also includes a 250-seat auditorium, study center, museum store, and the Camellia Court Café.
